The Board of Waterworks Commissioners of Water District No. 1, Parish of Lafourche, State of Louisiana, met in regular session at the Water Treatment Plant Distribution Office, Lockport, Louisiana, on Thursday, August 17, 2023, at six o'clock p.m.

All rose and recited the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

On motion by Mr. Nolan Cressionie, seconded by Mr. Bobby Grabert, the Board unanimously approved the minutes of the meeting held July 20, 2023.

Mr. Wayne Gautreaux, General Manager, updated the Board on continuing negotiations for potential purchase of property adjacent to South Plant north property line

from Raceland Raw Sugars for the new Administration Office location. With a verbal agreement allowing the Water District to purchase a small tract adjacent to the north property line, the Water District will move forward with hiring an engineer to subdivide the proposed tract for submission to the Parish Planning Department for approval.

Discussion was then held on the continuing issue of lower water levels of Bayou Lafourche due to drought conditions and low Mississippi River levels.

Mr. Gautreaux then presented a preliminary report on the possible transition to a Paid Time Off (PTO) policy in lieu of the existing Vacation/Sick Leave policy. Further discussion will be held with the Policy Research and Development Committee.

Finally, on motion by Mr. Barry Uzee, seconded by Mr. Eric Roundtree, the Board unanimously approved to adopt a resolution declaring list of vehicles as surplus and approving trade-in with Enterprise Fleet Management for future equity on leased vehicles.

JOB PROGRESS REPORT

Administrative Office Demolition

Lebro Construction, Inc. is the Contractor for this project. The Contractor is close to completion dismanteling the roof and should be completely finished with the project within the next month.

Waterline Replacement Along Gautreaux Street, et al

Muddy Pipeworks, LLC is the Contractor for this project. A Notice to Proceed has been issued and work will begin at the beginning of September.

Interior Paint and Repair of Bayou Blue Elevated Tank

This project is complete. We have Change Order #1 for your review tonight which entailed some additional coating required on the inside of the tank.

Lead Service Line Inventory

Phase 1(a) - Town of Lockport LPWD-Owned Service Line Verification

All 237 of the randomly selected verification sites have been completed with no lead found.

Phase 1(b) - Lafourche Parish Customer-Owned Service Line Verification

369 of the 378 randomly selected verification sites have been completed as of Tuesday. No lead has been found to date. We anticipated being complete with this phase of the project by the end of September.

Waterline Replacement Along W. 3rd Street, et al

This project will include installation of waterlines W. 3rd Street, W. 67th Street, E. 53rd Street, and Kelly Drive. W. 3rd Street and Kelly Drive were previously approved for waterline replacement at the September 15, 2022 meeting. Due to on-going issues with existing waterlines down E. 53rd Street and W. 67th Street, we are requesting that the Board approve adding these two streets to the current list of projects approved for construction. We anticipate beginning construction on these streets within the next 3 months.

Tank Maintenance Program

We've been in on-going discussions with D&M Tank about a long-term maintenance program for our tanks within the system. We are proposing to perform interior/exterior maintenance on Cut Off Tank, Valentine Tank, West Thibodaux Tank, St. Charles Tank, and South Plant Groun Storge Tank #3 within the next 10 years. We are proposing to perform this maintenance over the next 10 years, for \$250,000 per year through D&M Tank. We request the Board to approve the agreement with D&M Tank to perform this work.
