Water Line Relocation, LA1, Golden Meadow, SPN H.008145:

Bids were received on December 7, 2021. The lowest responsive bidder was LA Contracting Enterprise, LLC, with a bid of \$2,019,400.00. (A lower bid of \$1,774,975.98 from Shaw Construction Services was deemed non-responsive due to a problem with the envelope and with the bid bond.)

18" Water Line - Galliano to Cut Off:

Design for this project is ongoing. We submitted a preliminary set of bid documents to LPWD#1 staff for their review.

GIS Engineering, LLC (GIS) has reviewed the bids received on December 7, 2021, for the above referenced project. This letter addresses our review findings and recommendations for you and your board’s consideration. The bid results, as received at the bid opening, are listed below:

Enclosed, herewith, is a copy of the “Bid Evaluation Summary” containing GIS Engineering’s evaluation results of the bids received, and the “Bid Tabulation Summary” outlining the detailed dollar amounts for each bid item within each bid package received.

EVALUATION:

The apparent low bidder, as read at the bid opening, is **Shaw Construction Services, LLC**, with a bid in the amount of **\$1,774,975.98**. Shaw Construction Services did not have the project name plainly marked on the sealed envelope containing their bid and did not properly sign the Bid Bond. After evaluation of their bid package, and preliminary discussions with LPWD1, GIS considers the bid of Shaw Construction Services, LLC, to be **non-responsive**.

The apparent responsive low bidder is **LA Contracting Enterprise, LLC**, with a bid in the amount of **\$2,019,400.00**. After evaluation of their bid package, all bid documents were submitted as required and in compliance with the contract documents; therefore, GIS considers LA Contracting Enterprise, LLC, to be the responsive low bidder.

RECOMMENDATION:

Based on our evaluation of all bids submitted, contingent upon concurrence by the Lafourche Parish Water District No. 1 and its legal counsel, GIS Engineering, LLC, recommends award of the Waterline Relocation in Conjunction with State Project No. H.001845 Contract to the responsive low bidder, **LA Contracting Enterprise, LLC**.

SOUTH PLANT FLOCCULATOR TROUGHS REPLACEMENT PHASE 2:

Plans and specs for Phase 2 are complete and ready to send to the Contractor for pricing. The final price quote will be provided to the Board for approval.

SOUTH PLANT CARBON FEED SYSTEM UPGRADE:

Progress on the electrical and structural portions of the design and drawings are continuing. Electrical work will include provisions to allow easier replacement in the future of electrical equipment in the Chemical Building.

NORTH PLANT RAW WATER TRANSFER PUMP UPGRADE:

Yard piping is complete. The pump and VFD equipment are stored locally at the suppliers nearby office to the District. Some other material delivery is expected this week. Site work is expected to resume in early January after discussions and coordination with plant operations staff on work that will temporarily shutdown some plant operations during such work.
