**For: Customers South of our Leeville Booster Station (located at 22884 Hwy 1, Leeville)**

Lafourche Parish Water District No. 1 is using this public service announcement to serve as a notice that the District is planning to conclude its free chlorine treatment and return to chloramines on **Tuesday, December 7, 2021**. This will only affect customers below the Leeville Booster Station at 22884 Hwy 1, which includes all customers serviced by the District:

- in the communities along and adjoining Hwy 1, between 22884 Hwy 1 in Leeville (Leeville Booster Station) and the Lafourche-Jefferson parish line
- in the communities along and adjoining Hwy 3090 in Fourchon

LDH encourages customers in the affected areas to review the “Water Treatment Change Coming Soon” section below.

#### **Water Treatment Change Coming Soon:**

##### **What is being done?**

Lafourche Parish Water District No. 1 will discontinue its free chlorine treatment and resume its normal chloramines disinfection.

##### **When is this switch scheduled?**

The transition from free chlorine to chloramines is scheduled to commence on **Tuesday, December 7, 2021**.


##### **What can you expect?**

You may experience a temporary increase in chlorine odor during the transition from free chlorine to chloramines. This odor is normal and should subside within a few days.

##### **What should I do?**

Keep doing what you are doing now.
