Water Line Replacement, Cliff Lane, et al:

Bids were received on June 14, 2018. The Water District awarded the construction contract to Sampey General Contractors, Inc., in the amount of \$408,590.00. The contract is being processed. Contractor will be scheduled to begin after they complete other projects for the Water District.

Water Line Relocation, LA1, Golden Meadow, SPN H.008145:

The construction contract was awarded to LA Contracting Enterprise, LLC, for \$2,019,400.00. A Notice to Proceed was issued for March 7, 2022. The Contractor plans to remove the existing 12" waterline soon, but the bulk of the work will not be started until late April because of delays in procuring materials.

SOUTH PLANT FLOCCULATOR TROUGHS REPLACEMENT PHASE 2:

The construction contracts with Sealevel Construction, Inc. are currently being executed and recorded by the District. A Notice to Proceed will be issued soon.

SOUTH PLANT CARBON FEED SYSTEM UPGRADE:

The electrical and structural drawings are being finalized for review by District staff in the next couple of weeks. A request for Board approval for bid advertising is expected next month.

NORTH PLANT RAW WATER TRANSFER PUMP UPGRADE:

The new pump and VFD equipment are on site but not installed yet. Contractor has ordered flexible pipe fitting to allow final installation of the new pump equipment and pump installation should happen in a few weeks.

NEW SURGE PROTECTION TANK AT SOUTH WATER TREATMENT PLANT:

Tank delivery has been made and installation of the tank and yard piping is underway.

NORTH PLANT CAPACITY EXPANSION:

Detailed design work and construction drawing preparation is progressing. Further review of progress components with District staff is expected next month.

LEEVILLE BOOSTER STATION PUMP SELECTION ASSISTANCE:

We completed system modeling and analysis to assist District staff in selecting the appropriate pump size for the new pumps to be installed in the rebuilt station. Our recommendation for the preferred pump has been provided to District staff for review.
