The Board of Waterworks Commissioners of Water District No. 1, Parish of Lafourche, State of Louisiana, met in regular session at the Water Treatment Plant Distribution Office, Lockport, Louisiana, on Thursday, June 16, 2022, at six o'clock p.m.

All rose and recited the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.
