Bids were received on June 14, 2018. The Water District awarded the construction contract to Sampey General Contractors, Inc., in the amount of \$408,590.00. Contractor is scheduling work to begin at the end of August.

Water Line Relocation, LA1, Golden Meadow, SPN H.008145:

The construction contract was awarded to LA Contracting Enterprise, LLC, for \$2,019,400.00. A Notice to Proceed was issued for March 7, 2022. The Contractor has removed the existing 12" waterline. The borings under Highway 3235 have been completed. Contractor has begun installing the water lines for the project.
